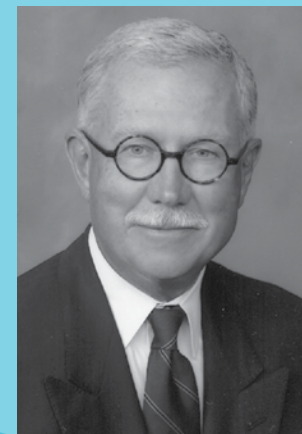


WELCOME TO THE SHEPHERD EYE CENTER

JOHN R. SHEPHERD, M.D., EMERITUS

The founder of the Shepherd Eye Center, Dr. John Shepherd, is recognized as one of the early leaders in small incision cataract surgery. He began practice in Las Vegas in 1968, establishing the best eye care center in the city for the last forty years.



STEVEN O. HANSEN, M.D., F.A.C.S.

Dr. Steven Hansen attended the University of Texas and received his medical degree from Texas Tech University Health Science Center. He completed his internship and residency at University Hospital in Salt Lake City, Utah and received advanced training in ocular pathology and intraocular lens research while completing his fellowship at the University of Utah.

Dr. Hansen has served as an investigator for the implantable contact lens (ICL) as well as the Nidek EC-5000 excimer laser. He has also served as Medical Director for the Nevada Donor Network eye bank.

Dr. Hansen is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology. He is a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery, and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He joined the Shepherd Eye Center in 1992, bringing his expertise in small incision cataract surgery to the practice.



STEVEN N. MONTGOMERY, M.D., F.A.C.S.

Dr. Steven Montgomery attended the University of Utah and received his medical degree from the University of Utah School of Medicine, where he also completed his internship. He received advanced training in ocular microsurgery as well as refractive surgery while completing his residency at the University of Oklahoma, Dean A. McGee Eye Institute.

Dr. Montgomery is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and is a member of both the American Academy of Ophthalmology and the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He joined the Shepherd Eye Center in 1995, bringing his expertise in small incision cataract and refractive surgery to the practice. Dr. Montgomery has served as a primary investigator for the Nidek EC-5000 excimer laser as well as the first FDA-approved accommodating intraocular lens.

While at Shepherd Eye Center, Dr. Montgomery has served as Secretary for the Nevada Ophthalmological Society, member of Am Surg's Physician Advisory Committee, and as Medical Director of the Shepherd Eye Surgicenter.



DAN L. EISENBERG, M.D.

Dr. Eisenberg is the Glaucoma Specialist for the Shepherd Eye Center. His practice is entirely devoted to the treatment of patients with glaucoma. Under his direction, the Shepherd Eye Center is able to provide advanced diagnostic testing and treatment for all types of glaucoma.

Dr. Eisenberg earned his bachelor degree and medical degree from Boston University. He completed 3 glaucoma research fellowships and his ophthalmology residency at the New England Eye Center, Tufts University in Boston. He received advanced training with a specialized fellowship in glaucoma diagnosis, treatment and glaucoma surgery at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, Nebraska.

Dr. Eisenberg has published over two dozen articles and abstracts relating to glaucoma and is actively involved in glaucoma research. He is a member of the Association for Research and Vision in Ophthalmology, The American Academy of Ophthalmology, The American Society for Cataract and Refractive Surgery and the American Glaucoma Society. Dr. Eisenberg is Board Certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology.



ROBERT B. TAYLOR, III, M.D., F.A.C.S.

Dr. Robert Taylor completed his pre-medical studies at Southern Methodist University, and received his medical degree from the University of Texas at Houston. He completed his internship at the University of Pennsylvania and received advanced training in small incision cataract surgery and refractive surgery while completing his residency at the University of Oklahoma, Dean McGee Eye Institute. He completed additional LASIK and PRK surgical training in Toronto, Canada and was one of the first surgeons to offer Conductive Keratoplasty (CK) for the correction of presbyopia.

Dr. Taylor moved to Las Vegas in 1994, and has been in both private practice as well as group practice with Southwest Medical Associates, where he helped develop their Department of Ophthalmology. He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and has served on numerous committees for the Clark County Medical Society. Dr. Taylor joined the Shepherd Eye Center in 2001, bringing his expertise in small incision cataract surgery and refractive surgery to the practice.



RAVI K. REDDY, M.D., F.A.C.S.

Dr. Ravi Reddy received his medical degree from the University of Michigan and completed his residency at the Case Western School of Medicine/University Hospitals of Cleveland. During his training, he received advanced training in oculoplastic surgery and ocular microsurgery. Over the last several years, he has served as Principal Investigator for numerous FDA-monitored drug studies involving dry eye syndrome and glaucoma. He has a special interest in eyelid disorders such as ptosis, tumors, and malpositions.

Dr. Reddy is Board Certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons. While serving his country in the United States Air Force, Major Reddy held the position of Chief of Ophthalmology at Mike O'Callaghan Federal Hospital, Nellis Air Force Base. He has been in private practice in Las Vegas since 1991. Dr. Reddy joined the Shepherd Eye Center in 2006, bringing his expertise in oculoplastic surgery to the practice.



JACK L. KANE, M.D., J.D., F.A.C.S.

Dr. Jack Kane received his medical degree from Indiana University Medical School, where he completed both his internship and residency. He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology, and is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons.

RICHARD W. THATCHER, M.D., F.A.C.S.

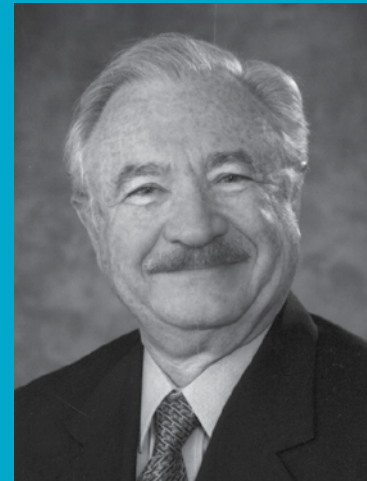

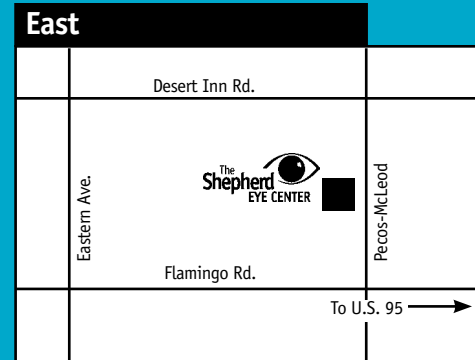


**JUDY M. CRAYTHORN,
M.D.**

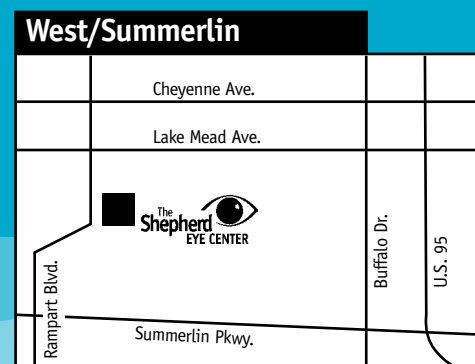

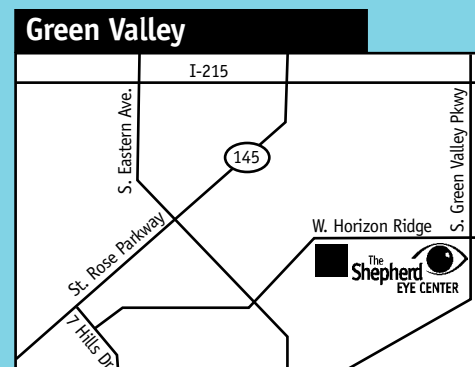

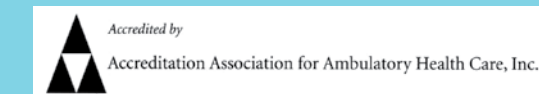
PRACTICE OF THE YEAR

NATIONALLY ACCREDITED



The Shepherd Eye Center has participated in an extensive on-site survey of its facilities and services by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC). During the survey, many physicians and health care administrators evaluated nearly every aspect of patient care. The result was the Shepherd Eye Center being awarded accreditation by AAAHC - the first ophthalmic practice and ambulatory surgical center in Nevada to receive this honor. This accreditation was first received in 1983. Our most recent survey was conducted in 2007 in our facility at 3575 Pecos-McLeod. After completing this evaluation, our practice was awarded the highest rating available for 3 years.
